Notice is hereby given that the Town of Cumberland, Indiana will receive sealed bids in the Offices of the Cumberland Police Department, PO 29177, Cumberland, IN 46229, or mailed to the Cumberland Police Department, same address, no later than 4:00 o'clock p.m. (local time), October 26, 2018 for 6 Chevrolet Tahoes PPV for the Cumberland Police Department that meet all specifications below. Bid price on this equipment, F.O.B., Cumberland, Indiana, less all state and federal taxes.

The specifications and desired features for the vehicles are:

- Make and Model: Chevrolet Tahoe
- Color: Black
- 2 Wheel drive
- Auxiliary dome lamp
- Head and tail light flasher systems
- Police package
- Pursuit rated
- Six extra factory keys
- Front tow hooks
- All-weather floor liners first and second rows
- Delivery date December 2018
- Cumberland PD will pick up vehicles from dealership

All bids must be guaranteed and firm for a period of 60 days following acceptance, and bidders must certify that delivery shall be made in December 2018.

Bids will be evaluated on the basis of the following factors: equipment features, quality, availability of service; warranty provisions; ease and cost of maintenance; delivery date; and cost. Within 14 calendar days after receiving official notification of award, the successful bidder must provide a performance bond equal to 100% of the contract price. The successful bidder and surety company must agree to bind themselves, their successors, executors, administrators, and assigns, jointly and severally, to deliver the vehicles to the specifications, intent of specifications, special and general conditions and to the purchase order. This bond must remain in force until the vehicles have been delivered and accepted.

All bids will be opened at a public meeting on Monday October 29, 2018 at 10am, in the Town Hall Chambers at 11501 E. Washington Street, Cumberland, Indiana. Bids may be taken under advisement for review. The Town will notify the successful bidder of its acceptance within 15 days after opening bids, but acceptance may be subject to the Town securing adequate financing. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids if it determines it is in the Town's best interest to do so, and to waive any informality in bidding.
